DIWALI FESTIVLES (DHAN-TERAS)

Birthday of Lord Dhanvantari and Goddess Laxmi

SIGNIFICANCE OF ZODIAC SIGN

- > The Libra rules business and the professional life.

- > The Swati Nakshatra is linking to Tridevi: Goddess Luxmi, Saraswati and Maha-kali.

DIWALI POOJAN

- Ganesha, God of intelligence and lord of Muladhara chakra, removes obstacles. Saraswati represents swadistana chakra, supply the knowledge of creation and signifies harmony in life. Lakshmi represents Manipura chakra and is the supplier if infinite wealth. These three chakras combines for the healthy and wealthy life with happiness.
- Goddess Kali, Lord Vishnu and Kuber are worshipped and pay reverence to record-books and wealth related equipment.



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DIWALI FESTIVALS (Govardhan Puja and Bhai duj)

- Govardhan Puja with Annakuta signifies importance given to vocal to local.
- Diwali festival is concluded with Bhai Duja festival which is observed as a symbol of love between sisters and brothers and signifies the importance of relationship for the happy life.
